



Agile Project Leadership – Level I – 2-day Course

Course Overview

The goAgile Agile Project Leadership Foundation course introduces Agile processes like xP, Scrum, Crystal and DSDM – and gives a basic understanding about the principles in Agile and iterative development processes. The course also covers the Project Leaders new role in this kind of projects – by introducing facilitation and collaboration skills.

We cover the various roles, products and activities in a basic Agile project – and we talk about the relationship between these 3 process elements. Furthermore the importance of building relationships and use these relationships in creating a genuine general common understanding of the project goals is discussed.

The course is a mix of lecture, practical hands-on exercises and cases from various Agile projects to illustrate the principles being explored.

All written course materials are in English. The course is led by Ole Jepsen and conducted in Danish.

*The course will also prepare candidates for the DSDM Agile Foundation Certification Programme.**

Day 1: Set up and plan the project

- The basics of Agile
- Agile processes – xP, Scrum, Crystal and DSDM
- Building relationships and create a common understanding
- Introduction to Use Case Camps
- Preparing and running a planning session

Day 2: Run and tune the project

- Basic facilitation and collaboration techniques
- Standup meetings and Demos
- Delivering at the end of each iteration
- Looking for—and adapting to feedback
- Optimising the process
